

## Easter – Timetable

A suggested timetable of the events over the Easter weekend which was possibly 29 March – 5 April 33 AD

### Thursday

6.00 pm	Jesus & disciples began the 'Last Supper'. They were celebrating Passover 24 hours early
8.00 – 9.00 pm	Judas left to betray Jesus. Caiaphas started to arrange an unexpected meeting of the Sanhedrin and organise an impromptu trial.
9.30 – 10.00	Jesus & the 11 disciples went to the Garden of Gethsemane
11.30 – midnight	Jesus was arrested

### Friday

12.30 am	The arrest party arrived at Caiaphas' house
1.00 – 3.00 am	Trial by the Sanhedrin
6.00 am	Jesus taken to Pilate for trial
7.00 am	Jesus sent to Herod
8.00 am	Back to Pilate; flogged & sentenced
9.00 am	Jesus was crucified
12 noon	Darkness for 3 hours
3.00 pm	Jesus died; earthquake; curtain of the Temple tore in two Jesus was on the cross at the same time as the Passover lambs were traditionally sacrificed
4.00 pm	Joseph of Arimathea asked for Jesus' body
5.30 pm	Jesus was laid in the tomb by Joseph & Nicodemus

### Saturday Sabbath – everyone rested

The Jewish leaders asked Pilate for permission to post a guard at the tomb for 3 days.

### Sunday

Dawn	Jesus rose from the dead; Angels arrived to move the stone; earthquake; guards fainted; angel spoke to the women who had arrived to attend to the grave
6.30 am	Peter & John ran to see the empty tomb
7.00 am	Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene
Late am/ early pm	Jesus appeared to Peter
Late afternoon	Jesus walked to Emmaus with 2 followers
Evening	Jesus appeared to 10 of the disciples in the upper room
8 days later	Jesus appeared to 11 of the disciples

### Other recorded resurrection appearances

- To 7 disciples fishing in Galilee
- To 11 disciples on a mountain in Galilee
- To over 500 people at once (1 Corinthians 15 v.6)
- To James the brother of Jesus
- At the ascension – Acts 1
