



# The Tube Journey Game

## Aim

To guess the name of the London underground tube station from the crossword type clue given. As a help players could look at a map of the tube and be given the name of the line. This can be written on the reverse side of the clue card.

This game can be used as part of a journeys' theme or just for fun.

## How to play

Print and cut out the clues and stick them up around the meeting room.

Some groups may like to also print out the answers so that players can match the clue with the answer.

Otherwise give out the clues on a sheet of paper and players can write the answers alongside. As below, but allow more space to write.
