1. I will not forget you! See, I have engraved you **on the palms of my hands**. Isaiah 49:16
2. **You** are precious to me.....I give you honour and love you, Isaiah 43:4
3. Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet **my unfailing love** for you will not be shaken. Isaiah 54:10.
4. I am the Lord your God, who holds **your right hand**, and I tell you, 'Don't be afraid. I will help you.' Isaiah 41:13
5. Two sparrows cost only a penny, but not even one of them can die without your Father's knowing it. God even knows how many hairs are on your head. So don't be afraid. You are worth much more than many **sparrows**. Matthew 10:29-31
6. Nothing - not life nor death, angels nor demons can cut off **God's love supply to us**. Nothing. End of story. Romans 8:39 - Street Bible
7. People trust God all the time. Tell him **all your problems**, because God is our protection. Psalm 62:8
8. The Lord reached down from above and took me; he pulled me **from the deep water**. Psalm 18:16

9. You, Lord, give true peace to those who depend on you, because they **trust you**. Isaiah 26:3
10. Do not worry about anything, but pray and ask God for everything you need, always giving thanks. And God's peace, which is so great we cannot understand it, will keep **your hearts and minds** in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7
11. But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and he chose the **weak** things of the world to shame the strong. He chose what the world thinks is **unimportant** and what the world looks down on and thinks is **nothing** in order to destroy what the world thinks is important. 1 Corinthians 1:27-28
12. **Being with you** will fill me with joy; Psalm 16:7 – 11
13. We know that in everything God works for the good of those who love him. Romans 8:28
14. But if we **confess our wrongdoing**, he will forgive our sins, because we can trust God to do what is right. He will cleanse us from all the wrongs we have done. 1 John 1:9
